ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

Curious About Catholicism? Discover OCIA! The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA), formerly known as the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA), is the process through which unbaptized adults and those baptized in other Christian traditions become full members of the Catholic Church. It is a journey of faith, conversion, and spiritual formation that welcomes individuals into the Catholic community.

The purpose of OCIA is to help individuals learn about Catholic teachings, practices, and traditions; become part of the parish community and grow in relationship with other Catholics; grow in prayer and understanding of God's love; and prepare for and receive the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism (if unbaptized), Confirmation, and Eucharist – which fully welcome them into the Church.

The OCIA journey typically unfolds in several stages:

Period of Evangelization and Pre-catechumenate:

This initial period is a time for inquiry and discovery. Individuals explore their interest in the Catholic faith, ask questions, and begin to understand the Gospel message.

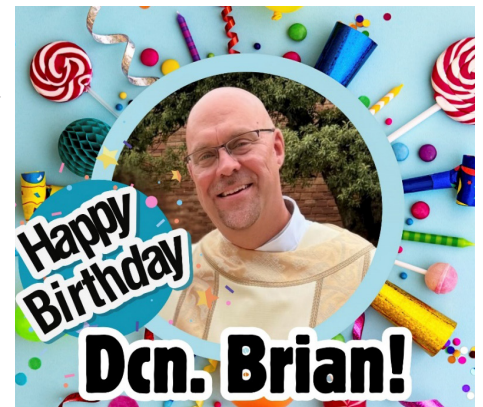
Period of the Catechumenate:

After a Rite of Acceptance, participants become "catechumens" (if unbaptized) or "candidates" (if baptized). This is a period of formation where they learn about Catholic doctrine, moral teachings, prayer, and liturgy, guided by catechists and sponsors.

Period of Purification and Illumination:

This stage usually coincides with Lent and is a time of intense spiritual preparation, marked by prayer, reflection, and rites that help purify intentions and deepen conversion. It culminates in the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil.

If you are interested in exploring the Catholic faith or becoming a full member of the Catholic Church, please talk with Fr. Joseph or Janie Miller (if you haven't done so already), and join in our first gathering on Saturday, September 19, at 9:00 a.m. in the Our Lady of Hope rectory basement.

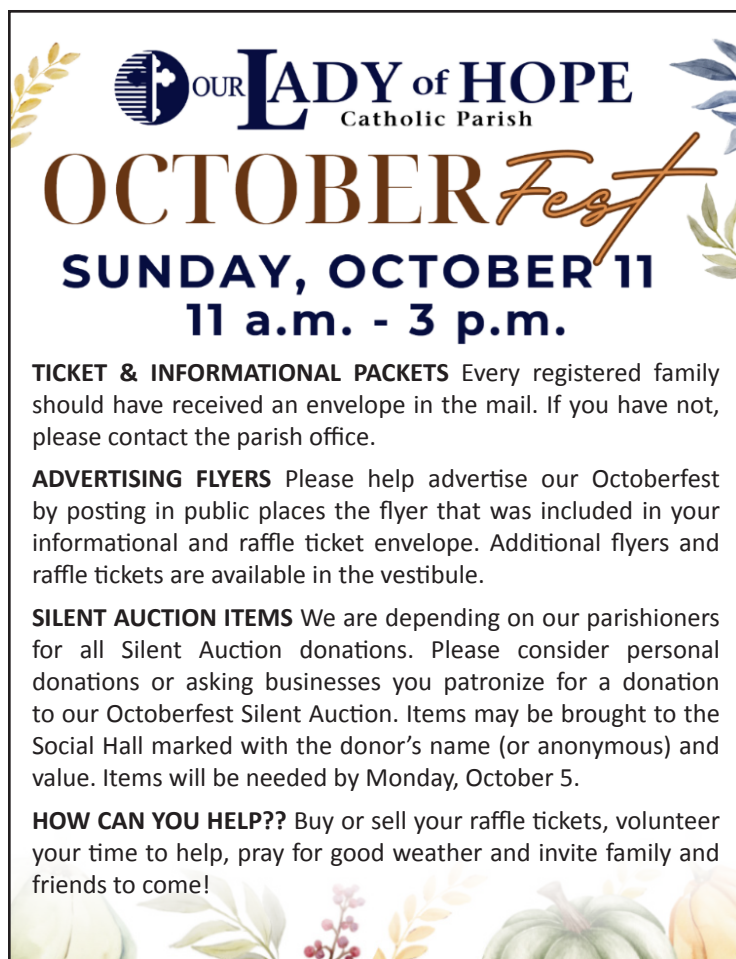

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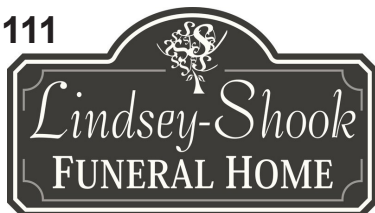
