A WORD FROM DEACON BRIAN

***“It’s not my fault.”***

As a young man, I learned (often the hard way) this excuse was not acceptable in my parents’ house. I can remember being very frustrated with them because to me, *“it’s not my fault”* was often an honest and accurate explanation of whatever problem I found myself in.

My curfew was Midnight, and Midnight meant 12:00 a.m., not 12:01 a.m. One of the first nights I had gone out, I was stopped by a train and got home 5 minutes late. Mom was waiting for me at the door. I explained how it was *“not my fault”* because I had to wait on the train. To my 16-year-old self, this seemed reasonable and no big deal. Mom was quick to show me the error in my thought process.

While I couldn’t see it at the time, coming home five minutes late wasn’t really mom’s point. It was that I never left myself enough time to allow for something like a train. Her point was that not only did I not set myself up for success, but I made it worse by not accepting responsibility for failure.

Just as there was more to my getting home at 12:05 a.m. instead of 12:00 a.m., in today’s Gospel, Jesus is telling us there is more to the commandments than just *“you shall not.”* *“You have heard that it was said to your ancestors, you shall not kill; and whoever kills will be liable to judgment. But I say to you, whoever is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment.”* *“You have heard that it was said, you shall not commit adultery. But I say to you, everyone who looks at a woman with lust has already committed adultery with her in his heart.”*


Jesus is telling us, sin begins in our heart and then sin comes to life in the choices we make. Choices are really what the readings are about on this Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time. The first reading from Sirach tells us, good and evil...it’s all out there to choose from, and in the second reading from Corinthians, Paul tells us to choose with the wisdom of God, not the wisdom of this age.

Spend time in prayer – work on your heart, so that sin never has the chance to come to life in your choices. Paul’s warning to embrace the wisdom of God is the blunt advice we need, because *“it’s not my fault”* will not be an acceptable answer when it comes time to answer for those choices.


