A WORD FROM THE PASTOR

2020-2021 Financial Reports

As you will see in this week's bulletin, we included the financial statements for both parishes for the entire fiscal year of 2020-2021. Just some general comments (and if you have any particular questions, never hesitate to ask me), first, both parishes did really well. Both were above budget for income, and below budget for expenses. So, at the bottom line "Total Ordinary Income/Expense," you will see that St. Gaspar was in the black with \$129,112.00, and Our Lady of Hope was in the black with \$75,003.00. Kindly keep in mind that through your generosity, this will be used to help offset significant projects coming up.

You will also notice that in the "Balance" section for St. Gaspar, there is a line called "Ameriprise." Over a year ago, the finance council decided to put some of their funds into investments through Sutton Bank. The intention is that these funds are not needed in the near term, and we would like for this to grow to help offset greater future needs. It essentially will operate as an endowment. I think this is very wise and forward thinking. It's akin to the movement that all five cemeteries made with Fr. Paul in creating their endowments. It is my intention that Our Lady of Hope will follow suit once our projects are completed.

Other Happenings

Mark your calendars now for **October 5, 6:00 p.m., at St. Gaspar**, we will be having our **Rosary In Song**. This is a beautiful ceremony where the Rosary is prayed to song, and it's a special way to recognize our Lady as October is the month of the Rosary.

In addition, on **October 6** we will have a **Blessing of Animals** at our PSR classes, in honor of St. Francis whose feast day is October 4. For Our Lady of Hope, we will begin outside at 6:15 p.m., and St. Gaspar's service will begin around 7:15 p.m. PSR parents will be receiving instructions shortly. If you have a child who is not of PSR age and would like their animal blessed, feel free to join us at either location... you will see how everyone is gathering and just join in!

Also mark your calendar for the K of C **Perch Fish Fry** on **October 1**. The drive-thru takes place between 4:00-6:30 p.m. It's \$14.00 for a dinner and \$17.00 for a pound of perch.

In addition, remember that next weekend after each Mass, we will have the **Blessing of Cars** in the parking lot, in honor of the feast of Guardian Angels on October 2. For our high schoolers who participate, they will receive a blessed St. Christopher medal for their car.

Finally, remember Our Lady of Hope's **Octoberfest** on **October 10**. We can always use an extra set of hands, so if you are interested in helping out, we have sign-up sheets in the back of church at Our Lady of Hope.

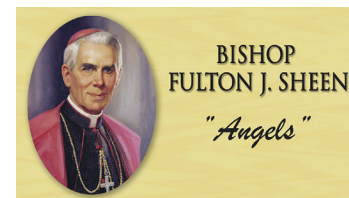
