SAINTS Carlo Acutis & Pier Giorgio Frassati – Canonized September 7, 2025

No longer "Blesseds," these modern young men are officially SAINTS as of this weekend! The joint canonization ceremony is to be held on Sunday, September 7, at St. Peter's Square in Rome, with His Holiness Pope Leo XIV presiding.



Carlo Acutis is the first "millennial" to be declared a saint. He was a British-born Italian student, and is celebrated for his devotion to the Eucharist and his use of digital media to promote Catholic devotion through a website he created – an online exhibition of Eucharistic miracles and Marian apparitions. Diagnosed with leukemia, he offered his suffering for both Pope Benedict XVI and the Catholic Church, saying, "I offer to the Lord the sufferings that I will have to undergo for the Pope and for the Church." The doctors treating his final illness had asked him if he was in great pain, to which he

replied, "There are people who suffer much more than me." His final words to his mother were, "Mom, don't be afraid. Since Jesus became a man, death has become the passage towards life, and we don't need to flee it. Let us prepare ourselves to experience something extraordinary in the eternal life." Carlo died at the age of fifteen.

Born: May 3, 1991, London, United Kingdom Died: October 12, 2006, Monza, Italy

Beatified: October 10, 2020, on behalf of Pope Francis



Pier Giorgio Frassati was an Italian Catholic activist and a member of the Dominican Third Order. Frassati was considered extraordinary in his "ordinariness" and is a great role model for "ordinary people" who strive to live their everyday lives to the fullest. He was called the "Man of the Beatitudes" by Saint John Paul II for his work of bringing comfort and happiness to those who were poor, suffering, and in need of mercy. He would regularly organize mountainclimbing trips with his close friends, with occasions for prayer, liturgies, and conversations about faith during their trek. The phrase

"Verso L'Alto," meaning "To the Heights" (written by Frassati on a photograph after what would become his final climb), has come to encapsulate his philosophy of mountaineering and his Catholic outlook on life and adventure. He died at age 24 after contracting polio, possibly from one of the people that he assisted.


