A WORD FROM DEACON BRIAN

For anyone who may not already know, I am in the 27th year of my career as an Agronomy Advisor for Sunrise Cooperative. I have spent my adult life working with farmers hoping to provide the products and services they need to make each crop year as successful as possible.

I'm old enough to have had many experiences with different products and ideas and I feel I have a good understanding of what will work and what won't work in the field. However, I also understand the moment you think you know it all, you quickly find out you don't. Farming and Mother Nature have a way of humbling even the most "seasoned" farmers and advisors.

If there is a more skeptical, questioning, wary group of buyers in the business world than the American Farmer, I'd like to hear about it. If I have learned anything, when bringing a new product or idea to a farmer, you better be able to tell them not just that they need to try it, but you better be able to tell them why (and you better be quick about it). In sales training 101, this is known as the *Why Behind the What*.

Today, in Matthew's Gospel of the Transfiguration, Jesus is giving His disciples and us, "the why behind the what." As incredible and important as they are, God's plan has never been merely about forgiveness and redemption. God's desire for us is not only forgiveness, but transformation. Transformation from our fallen nature to glorification! *"The Transfiguration gives us a foretaste of Christ's glorious coming, when he 'will change our lowly body to be like his glorious body.'" CCC556*

Christ is the head; our Catholic Church is the body. It only makes sense that what has happened to the head will also happen to the body. From a sermon by Saint Pope Leo the Great on the Transfiguration he says, *"With no less forethought he was also providing a firm foundation for the hope of holy Church. The whole body of Christ was to understand the kind of transformation that it would receive as His gift. The members of that body were to look forward to a share in that glory which first blazed out in Christ their head."*

The Transfiguration is crucial to our understanding of what God wants for us, because it shows us our faith in Jesus not only carries on past the cross, but even past His Resurrection. What we believe in Christ's Transfiguration we can believe for ourselves – one day, we will receive glorified bodies and souls and see the face of God.

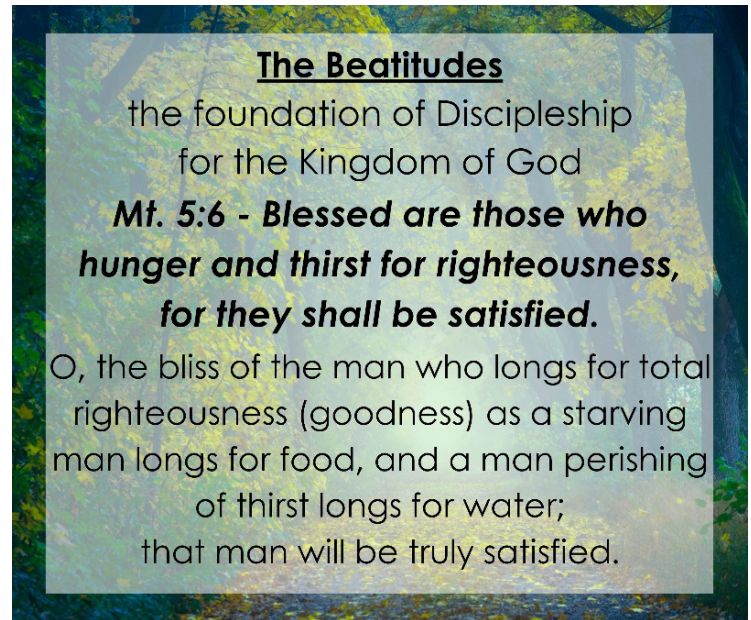
