A WORD FROM THE PASTOR



As we continue to rejoice in the light of Easter, the Church presents to us the beautiful encounter of the Risen Lord with His disciples on the road to Emmaus. On this Third Sunday of Easter, we see how discouraged hearts are transformed into burning hearts when they recognize Jesus in the breaking of the bread. The disciples, once filled with confusion and sadness, become joyful witnesses after encountering Christ in Word and

Eucharist. This reminds us that every Eucharistic celebration is an Emmaus moment—where Christ walks with us, speaks to us, and reveals Himself to us.

This Easter message connects deeply with the charism of the Pallottine Fathers and Brothers, inspired by St. Vincent Pallotti. His vision was simple yet powerful: to revive faith and rekindle charity in the hearts of all people. He believed that every baptized person is called to be an apostle, a missionary who brings the light of Christ to others. Like the disciples on the road, Pallottines seek to encounter Christ and then go forth with zeal to share that encounter with the world.

In a special way, this missionary spirit is alive and vibrant in the Pallottine missions in India. Across villages, towns, and remote regions, Pallottine missionaries dedicate their lives to proclaiming the Gospel, celebrating the sacraments, educating children, caring for the poor, and uplifting marginalized communities. Their work is not merely about providing material help, but about restoring dignity, hope, and faith—helping people experience the living presence of Christ in their lives.

Much like the disciples who said, “Were not our hearts burning within us?” the missionaries strive to ignite that same fire of faith in the hearts of those they serve. They walk with people in their struggles, share in their joys, and bring Christ’s compassion to the forgotten and the needy. Whether through schools, parishes, healthcare ministries, or social outreach programs, their mission continues to transform lives every day.

However, this important work cannot continue without the support of the wider Christian community. Just as the early disciples depended on one another, the missions today rely on your prayers and generosity. Your support becomes a concrete expression of your participation in the Church’s missionary call. By contributing to the Pallottine missions, you become partners in evangelization, helping to spread the Gospel and bring hope to countless lives.

On this Third Sunday of Easter, as we encounter the Risen Christ in the Eucharist, let us ask ourselves: Are our hearts burning with love for Him? Are we ready to share that love with others? Let us respond generously to this call. Through your prayers, encouragement, and financial support, you can help continue the mission of Christ in India and beyond. May the Risen Lord bless you abundantly for your kindness and generosity, and may your hearts always burn with the joy of His presence.

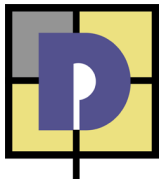
