A WORD FROM THE PASTOR

"STAY AWAKE...HE IS NEAR!"

Dear Parishioners.

Grace and peace to you as we begin a new liturgical year and enter the beautiful, hope-filled season of Advent. These four weeks are a sacred invitation — an invitation to slow down, to breathe, and to make room in our hearts for the God who comes to us in quiet, surprising, and grace-filled ways. Advent is not simply a countdown to Christmas. It is a season of longing. The Church invites us to look honestly at our lives and ask: Where do I need Christ's light? Where is the Lord inviting me to deeper faith, stronger hope, and renewed love?

This Sunday's message, "Stay Awake," is not about fear but attentiveness. God is always drawing close, but we can miss Him when we are distracted, overwhelmed, or spiritually asleep. Advent gently taps us on the shoulder and says, "Wake up – God is near!"

As we light the first purple candle, the Candle of Hope, we remember that the world is often shadowed by uncertainty, struggle, or discouragement. Yet our faith proclaims that God enters every darkness with His light. Let this candle remind us that hope is not wishful thinking—it is confidence in God's faithfulness.

I warmly encourage you to embrace one small spiritual practice this Advent: Spend ten quiet minutes a day in prayer, attend a weekday Mass or an evening of Adoration, offer forgiveness to someone, perform a simple act of kindness for a neighbor, Pray as a family around your Advent wreath. These small steps prepare a beautiful manger in our hearts for Christ.

As a parish family, we will journey together through these weeks of expectant waiting. May this Advent renew our joy, strengthen our faith, and help us recognize Christ's presence in our daily lives. Dear friends, let us stay awake, stay hopeful, and stay close to the Lord, for He is indeed coming—into our world and into our hearts. Wishing you a blessed and grace-filled Advent season.

engaging, practical reflection.




